



Instrument of Government

1. The name of the school is Alton Infant School
2. This school is a Community School
3. The name of the governing body is “The governing body of Alton Infant School”
4. The governing body shall consist of:
 - a. 2 parent governors
 - b. 1 Local Authority governor
 - c. 1 Headteacher
 - d. 1 staff governor
 - e. 6 Co-Opted governors [The total number of co-opted governors who are eligible to be elected as staff governors, when counted with the staff governor and the headteacher, must not exceed one third of the total membership of the governing body]
5. Total number of governors is 11
6. This instrument of government comes into effect on 23rd October 2014
7. This instrument was made by order of Hampshire Local Education Authority on 2nd October 2014
8. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body
