



Website Accessibility Statement

This website is run by Alton Infant School and this statement applies to www.alton-inf.hants.sch.uk

Our website should be accessible for all users, allowing everyone to browse the information provided. To help with this, users can:

- Use browser or device settings to change the font, colours or contrast levels
- Zoom in up to 400% without text disruption
- Use a keyboard or speech recognition software to access and move around the website

Our website is also simple to read and understand without any unnecessary difficult wording

Accessibility Features

- Adaptable design – Our website is designed to adapt to different devices and screen sizes which include mobile phones, laptops, desktop computers and tablets.
- Keyboard Navigation – Our website can be navigated by using a keyboard.
- Text Readability – Throughout our website we use a clear font to ensure all users can read the words with ease. Adjustable text size is also available to increase readability.
- There is the option of a high visibility version of our website should a user need it.

Non-compliance with the accessibility regulations

School exemption

- This website is partially compliant with the [Web Content Accessibility Guidelines version 2.2](#) AA standard, due to 'the exemptions' listed below.
- Primary and Secondary schools or nurseries – except for the content people need in order to use their services, for example a form that lets you outline school meal preferences.

Non-compliant content

We are aware that some areas of our website are not fully accessible:

- Older PDF documents are not fully accessible to screen reader software.
- Embedded Google Maps are not accessible within the website
- Any forms with bespoke styling on the website may not be accessible.
- Photographs and videos: We endeavour to ensure that, where needed, we include frame titles and captioning for any photographs or videos. If any photographs or videos do not have a frame title or captions, so people using assistive technology cannot access the information, we will rectify this if we are notified. This fails WCAG 2.2 AA success criterion.
- Links: We will ensure that we include appropriate use of links and ensure that links are descriptive. If any links are not descriptive, so screen reader users cannot access the information, we will rectify this if we are notified. This fails WCAG 2.2 AA success criterion.

- Tables: We will ensure that tables have appropriate headings. If any tables don't have defined headings, so people using a screen recorder or keyboard navigation cannot access the information, we will rectify this if we have been notified. This fails WCAG 2.2 AA success criterion.
- Brand colours: We will ensure that our brand colours meeting the contrast ratio for the corresponding text size. If any text does not meet the contrast ration, so people with visual impairments cannot access the information, we will make changes if we are notified. This fails WCAG 2.2 AA success criterion.

Ongoing Efforts

We welcome feedback from users to improve accessibility throughout our website and we will ensure we keep up to date with evolving accessibility standards and best practices.

Third-Party Content

We aim to ensure that our website content is accessible. However, some third-party materials or linked resources may not fully meet accessibility standards. We welcome you to contact us if you have difficulties accessing external content.

Enforcement procedure
